

# ANNUAL QUALITY ASSURANCE REPORT 2006-2007

## PART – A

IQAC has initiated many measures and policies to improve and sustain the quality in curricular, co-curricular and extra – curricular activities in the year 2006-2007. A detailed plan of action is chalked out in the beginning of the year. A continuous supervision and guidance has been rendered by the IQAC to each department to actualize the proposed plan of that years.

### **The plan of action chalked out in the beginning of the year :**

- To introduce PG programmes in English and Mathematics to help the students continue their post graduate education in the same institution
- SF Courses M.A.English and M.Sc(CS & IT) are introduced.
- To offer Job Oriented papers within the syllabus in each subject, to give career guidance and entrepreneurship development as common papers
- To include certificate courses in each subject to enable the students earn extra credits
- To make the students socially conscious by offering common papers on Ethics, Social analysis, Value education and Environmental studies
- To teach them women empowerment by giving a paper on it
- To help the faculty complete Ph.D degrees
- To encourage the faculty to serve as guides for M.Phil and Ph.D degrees inside college campus and also in other universities

- To motivate the faculty to undertake minor and major research projects and to counsel them how to receive grants
- To inculcate in them the spirit of organizing seminars and workshops for the benefit of the teaching faculty of other colleges
- To make the teachers realize the necessity of attending National and International level seminars, Workshops and conferences
- To allow the teachers and guide them in publishing their research outcome and books on their subjects and on other areas like ‘Yoga and Meditation’, Personality Development to support student programmes
- To conduct special programmes for students like workshops on “Yoga and Meditation”, Personality Development
- To orient the students and enable them to participate in various competitions, seminars, workshops and programmes conducted by other colleges.
- To train the final year students in preparing team projects
- To make them learn how to use advanced softwares in leading companies
- To create an awareness among the students on environmental issues and projects
- To arrange for campus interviews for students inside college campus
- To prepare the students and escort them to attend campus interviews conducted in other colleges
- To inspire the students how to volunteer in community services.
- To teach them the values of mental and physical health
- To provide opportunities for them to acquire values and ethics

- To empower them by developing their leadership qualities and improving their communicative skills
- To allow them to use the mechanisms like Career Guidance cell, Entrepreneurship cell, Placement cell, Alumnae Association, Associations for all subjects, and Grievance Redressal cell.
- To purchase teaching Aids like T.V., Computers, audiovisual lessons, OHP, LCD for innovative teaching
- To update and improve the website for college and a detailed discussion with all members of the faculty to be carried out.
- To arrive at formats for introducing students assessment of Teachers in order to finalize a stock-taking of the output in the academic affairs and to revise teaching methods.
- To plan for innovations in the course structure and the syllabi.
- To receive feedback from students on all the new courses and make an assessment for changes to be carried out in future.
- To encourage all the departments by funding them to conduct seminars, symposiums, workshops and conferences
- To request all department to arrange for guest lectures and expose their students and faculty to the external resources as motivational force
- To make use of the activities of all associations and explore the talents and skills of the students
- To continue the publishing of college magazine

- **Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution**

The objectives of the institution is to empower rural women through higher education by equipping them with the concepts of model citizen and self \_reliance. The curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities are planned and carried out in accordance with the objective. Post graduate programmes are begun in English and Mathematics to fulfill the aspirations of women students in completing PG degrees in consonance with the expectation of their parents who do not allow them to move to distant places and studying in co- education colleges. Self-financing courses like M.A. English, M.Sc.(CS & IT) are introduced to effect a vertical mobility in higher education in the absence of aided-courses in the same subject. Each department has introduced job oriented papers. Career guidance and

Entrepreneurial development are offered as common papers to ensure more employability to rural women students. Papers on “Spoken English” and “Computer Literacy” are given as common papers to make them acquire soft skills and communicative skills. Papers like “Ethics and Culture”, ‘Yoga and Meditation, Personality Development’, Women empowerment, and ‘Social analysis” are framed for the benefit of the students. They are trained to learn the concepts of self-reliance, dignified personality, good citizenship and value systems for individual and the society. The objective of including such papers within the frame work of the syllabus is to mould them into responsible citizens of India.

Description about the New Programmes

## **2-1 Department of English :**

The PG course in English was started with an intention of satisfying the wide spread demand for English teachers with communication skills and linguistic Competency. The students have to be familiarized with various currents of the different kinds of genres, and the modern critical approaches to literatures. Job-Oriented papers like “Journalism and Mass communication”, “Classics in translations” and English Language Teaching” are introduced in order to tap at the hidden sources of students for new jobs in the fields of journalism, translation and language teaching.

## **2-2 Job Oriented Course:**

### **Entrepreneurial Development**

This paper is introduced to create an awareness among the women students to start their own shops and fulfil their desire of starting their own business ventures. This paper helps the students to prepare budget to identify their potential areas , the demand and supply of the products.

### **Career Guidance and Counseling**

This course was introduced to enable the students to perform well in the competitive examinations.

## **Need Based Course:**

### **Spoken English**

A certificate course in spoken English was introduced to all the first year students to enable them to acquire basic reading ,listening and speaking skills

### **Computer Literacy**

A certificate course in acquiring basic computer skills was introduced to the first year students to have a working knowledge of computers.

## **3.Innovations in Curricular Design:**

The Course pattern of the new PG programmes was structured by following these steps.

- Visiting autonomous institutions of the affiliated university and other universities to have interaction with the faculty for arriving at suitable curricular for the present generation of students.
- Scrutinizing the syllabi of these institutions and holding discussions among the existing members of the faculty to finalize the papers and the units.
- Remembering and identifying the immediate demands and the requirements of the employer.
- Taking care in dividing each paper into five units without diluting core- content of the course.

- A compulsory paper on research project to be introduced in PG programmes.
- Sending the syllabus to external experts to collect opinions and corrections even before the board of studies.
- Modifying the syllabus by carrying out the changes according to the suggestion made by the subject experts in the Board of studies.
- Getting the revised syllabus approved by the academic Council by presenting the curriculum before the members.
- The syllabi of UG and PG departments have to be revised once in three years.

**Department of English:**

The course pattern of the P.G course is designed to help the students improve their competence in communicative skills and to train them for competitive examinations. The following papers like American Literature, Translation, Comparative literature, Journalism, English language teaching are included in the curriculum to realize the objective of the course. In the world of technological domination at present, the students have to realize the necessity of developing skills in speaking and writing English for Print media, radio and television. The paper on Journalism will motivate them for such jobs. The project is introduced in the paper to inculcate in them a thirst for scholarly pursuit for literature.

## II. TEACHING LEARNING AND EVALUATION

The students from the adjacent schools who get admitted in this institution are mostly learners from ill-equipped teaching practices. The idea of learner centered education has to be introduced and developed among them. New and appropriable methodologies have to be discovered, and practiced by the faculty as experiments for effective learning. Mechanism has to be evolved through a continuous evolution of the performance of the students. The teaching techniques and the learning process have to be assessed periodically in order to improve the method or to drop the method for another one. For this assessment of the teaching learning the feed-back is introduced to gauge the opinion of the students.

The autonomous status has given the academic aspirations to evolve new teaching methods. The internal assessment is made a continuous teaching learning process, with the components like Assignment and

seminars along with tests. Each department makes efforts to change the learning more student centric. It is a realized fact by the faculty that the conventional method of ‘Talk and Listen’ will be a failure for the newly framed syllabus. As the students participation becomes essential for the course content the faculty adopts new teaching methods to enhance quality in teaching learning process.

### **Some of the New Teaching Methods**

1. Common monthly tests(Written)

For all three tests the Controller section publishes a time table in advance and conducts all the three tests with the same seriousness of the external examination

2. Assignment – Students are trained to do reference.

3. Seminar - Students present their views on a topic.

4. Quizes – Informal and Formal Quizes are conducted to sharpen the memory of students.

5. Group discussions- The group leader learns how to sum up the outcome of discussion.

6. Creative Writing – In Tamil and in English.

7. Field – Trip – For environmental studies and for subject learning.

8. Projects – III UG and PG students are guided to complete projects.

9. Guest Lectures of external Resource Persons.

10.Counseling for slow learners to find out the reasons and how to develop them.

11.Using teaching aids like OHP,LCD, Documentary /film,Audio lessons, TV Progrmmes, Video Lessons.

12.Paper presentation by students in seminars and competitions in other colleges .

13.Preparing models for learning lessons in science.

14.Making case studies.

15.Visiting banks, industries and companies for practical knowledge.

16.Brain storming to sharpen the quickness of reaction.

17.Collection of Newspaper clippings for preparing documents and journals

18.Preparing charts and posters for better understanding

19.Using computers to learn new lessons

20.Debates to enhance the analytical understanding of the students.

**Department of Tamil:**

Dramatization, Discussions, Seminar, Quiz, role play were a few methods adopted by the department of Tamil to improve the language and oratorical skills of students.

### **Department of English :**

The need based course “Spoken English” is offered by the department to all the beginners in UG courses. It is found out that the students have inhibition and shyness to open the mouths to speak in English. Hence the singing of nursery rhyme, playing games with English words and telling stories by looking at pictures were introduced first. Then they were given drills in pronouncing words and with correct accent. Audio cassettes were played to listen to dialogues. Role- play was used to make them speak. Video cassettes with interesting stories were played on the television to listen and then the listening comprehension was tested by giving questions. Poetic lines were memorized and recited. Self-introduction, welcome address, vote of thanks, describing objects and narrating experiences are done by using the models of quick learners. Dramatization of small scenes are done by the model groups to motivate others to learn spoken English with great interest. In the end of the course a feedback format is filled up by the students to assess the course content, the teaching technique, the resource of the teachers and the utility of the course.

### **Department of Mathematics :**

Assignment, Seminar, Paper presentation. Quiz. were the methods adopted by the department of Mathematics. Model preparation is another method adopted for UG students.

**Department of Physics:**

Assignment, Seminar, Quiz, Group discussion, objective type, surprise tests are adopted.

**Department of Chemistry:**

Apart from the traditional methods a few unique methods such as problem solving, brain storming, demonstration, on the spot study, field and industrial visit, model preparation, charts and posters were followed to impart knowledge and skills to students.

**Department of Zoology :**

Seminars, assignments, field visits, on the job training are a few methods adopted.

**Department of Botany :**

Group discussion, seminars, collection of plants, field visit are a few strategies adopted.

**Department of Commerce :**

The students were taken to banks and industries to have a practical knowledge of the banks. Debates, group discussion were conducted on current topics like Annual Budget and financial topics. Projects, industrial visits are made compulsory to the students.

**Department of History :**

Innovative methods like assignments, seminar, group discussion, paper presentation, field visit, project writing are adopted.

**Department of Computer Science:**

Industrial visit, On the job training, group discussion, individual projects, case study, paper presentation, collection of paper clippings, charts and posters are a few methods adopted to train the students

**1-2 Remedial Coaching:**

As most of the students are from rural area with poor, economic background and are from Tamil Medium it is necessary on the part of teachers to offer remedial coaching classes. All the departments conduct special Coaching/Remedial coaching classes for the slow learners to help them perform well in the University examinations.

## **2.Examination Reforms:**

Our college was conferred autonomy in the year 2005-2006. The Examination section conducts internal and external examination for UG and PG students. Academic efficiency is assessed by adopting different evaluation techniques (Internal test, seminars, assignments, class participation and Group discussion). By continuous assessment, students understand their position and they make their move in a right direction. Hence internal assessment is indispensable for quality enhancement.

### **Examination Pattern**

The conduct of Examination under autonomy is being executed by the Office of Controller of Examinations.

The performance of the students in each paper is assessed internally and externally.

## **Examination Fees**

The fee structure for the end semester examination for UG/PG/M.Phil., is the same as that of Mother Teresa Women's University.

## **Conduct of Examination**

The Principal is the Chief Superintendent for conducting the semester examinations, who in turn appoints hall superintendents and takes care of all other arrangements for the smooth conduct of the examination.

The remuneration for the Chief Superintendent, hall superintendents and others are the same as that of Mother Teresa Women's University.

## **Preparation of Question Papers**

Data sheets have been prepared and supplied to various colleges which are filled up by teachers who are willing to set question papers / value answer scripts. The panel is updated every semester by deleting those who have retired and adding new names.

The work of Question-paper setting is generally allotted mostly to outstation setters. Two sets of question papers are required to be set for regular papers and one set for arrears papers. The syllabi, model question papers, acceptance form, claim forms, white sheets, covers for question papers, scheme and a cover for returning the question papers, stationery, question bank (if any), books (if necessary) are sent to the paper-setters confidentially.

The question papers thus received are kept in the safe custody of the COE. A computer copy of each question paper is prepared in the office of the

COE and copies are printed using copy printer and xerox machine. The entire printing work is done confidentially within the office of COE.

### **Evaluation**

The valuation of answer scripts is done centrally by the external examiners, assisted by the staff of the office of the COE. All the Heads of the departments are the Chief Examiners of their respective subjects.

The UG papers are subject to single external valuation whereas PG papers have double valuation, done by the external examiners only. In case of double valuation a maximum difference of 10% of maximum marks is permitted. If the difference exceeds 10% of the maximum marks, the paper is earmarked for third valuation.

For UG papers 25% is allotted for internal assessment and 75% for external assessment. In case of PG / M.Phil., papers 40% is allotted for internal assessment and 60% for external assessment. There is no passing minimum for internal assessment. The external passing minimum is fixed as 26 out of 75 and aggregate passing minimum is fixed as 35% for all UG papers. The external passing minimum is 30 out of 60 and aggregate passing minimum is 50% for all PG and M.Phil., papers.

### **Publication of Results**

After the valuation of answer scripts is over, the marks are entered in the database, processed and mark galleys are printed. They are placed before the Award Committee comprising Chief Examiners and the senior most External

Examiners. Any grace marks or moderation to be awarded are decided by the Award Committee and the results are passed.

The final results are printed and the mark galleys are sent to the respective Departments and are also displayed on the College Notice Board.

The processing of results, printing of mark galleys and printing of mark sheets are done entirely at the office of the COE. The semester-wise mark sheets are issued at the end of every semester.
